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## Chronic Wound: Post Surgical

- 73-year-old male developed a post operative foot wound secondary to poor circulation
  - Surgery: January 10, 2020
- Following surgery patient developed a dehiscence, necrosis of the wound bed and non-healing wound. An angioplasty to improve blood flow to leg was performed in March 2020.
- Wound remained chronic, non-healing and needed attention
  - REVITY applied to wound bed, June 11, 2020
  - One, 30 second application of REVITY after sharp debridement.
  - Moist wound healing with daily hydrogel bandage changes.

March 11, 2020



### 4 DAYS

AFTER REVITY TREATMENT

3.1cm x 2.2cm x 0.3cm

June 15, 2020



### 6 WEEKS

POST REVITY TREATMENT

2.4cm x 0.7cm x 0.1cm

July 16, 2020



### 8 WEEKS

POST REVITY TREATMENT

0.5cm x 0.5cm x 0.1cm

August 5, 2020



### 9 WEEKS

POST REVITY TREATMENT
